

# Notice to Competitors

MWGA 4 Ball

June 21-22, 2010

Hastings CC

## Play is governed by the USGA rules of golf, MWGA local rules and conditions, and this notice

- Tee markers:** There are two sets of tees for this tournament. Play is from the **blue** MWGA tee markers for the championship flight and from the **white** MWGA tee markers for players in all other flights.
- Yardage Markers:** Plates in fairway from 250 yards to 75 yards in 25 yard increments. Also, most sprinkler heads are marked.
- Hole Locations:** Refer to hole location sheet.
- Out of Bounds:** Defined by fences, white stakes and white lines.
- Water Hazards:** Holes #7 and #15. Water hazards are *identified* by yellow stakes and *defined* by yellow lines.
- Lateral Water Hazards:** Holes #1, #5, #6, #14 & #16. Lateral water hazards are *identified* by red stakes and *defined* by red lines.
- Ground Under Repair:** White lined areas. Mandatory relief for a ball that lies in a flower bed. A “drop zone” has been added behind and to the right of the 9<sup>th</sup> green. This may be used as an additional option for a ball that lies in the flower bed behind the 9<sup>th</sup> green. This “drop zone” may be used even if it is closer to the hole than where the ball lies. All of the “native grass” areas are to be played as “through the green”. Play the ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 27 (Ball Lost) or Rule 28 (Ball Unplayable).
- Obstructions:** Refer to Rule 24.
- Rakes:** Leave rakes *outside* the bunkers.
- Rest Areas:** 4<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> tees.
- Drinking Water:** 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, & 16<sup>th</sup> tees.
- Decisions On Ties:** In the event of a tie, there will be a 3 hole play-off on holes #1, #2, #5. If still tied, sudden death starting on #1 and continuing until a winner is determined.

## Severe Weather Course Evacuation Plan

**Signals**                      **One (1)** long blast = Discontinue Play *immediately*  
**Two (2)** short blasts = Resume play

In the event of severe weather, go to the clubhouse or the maintenance building to the left of the driving range. If a player believes she is in danger from lightning, she may discontinue play *without* permission from the Committee.
