

Notice to Competitors

MWGA Junior

Play is governed by the USGA rules of golf, MWGA local rules and conditions, and this notice

- Tee markers:** There are two sets of tees for this championship. Play is from the **blue** MWGA tee markers for the championship flight and from the **white** MWGA tee markers for players in all other flights.
- Yardage Markers:** Plates in fairway from 75 yards to 225 yards in 25 yard increments.
- Hole Locations:** Refer to hole location sheet.
- Out of Bounds:** Defined by fences, white stakes and white line on the edge of the cart path on # 18.
- Water Hazards:** Water hazards are *identified* by yellow stakes and may be *defined* by yellow lines. A “Drop Zone” has been established on hole #11 on the forward tee. This may be used as an additional option under Rule 26-1.
- Lateral Water Hazards:** Lateral water hazards are *identified* by red stakes and may be *defined* by red lines. “Drop Zones” have been established on holes #1 and # 17. These may be used as an additional option under Rule 26-1 for a ball that lies in the lateral water hazard behind the putting green. The ball must have entered the hazard between the green stakes.
- Ground Under Repair:** White lined areas. **Mandatory relief for any ball that lies in a flower bed.**
- Obstructions:** **If a ball strikes an elevated power line on hole #1, the stroke must be canceled and replayed, without penalty (see Rule 20-5).** If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted. Rocks adjacent to or lining cart paths are to considered part of the cart path. The poles on the left side of hole #1 are considered an integral part of the course (NO RELIEF). “Drop Zones” have been established on holes #8 and #13 for a ball that lies on the cart path (between the green stakes) near the green. If you use this option, you must use the closest “drop zone”, even if it is closer to the hole than where the ball lies.
- Rakes:** Leave rakes *inside* the bunkers.
- Rest Areas:** 6th tee and behind 13th tee.
- Drinking Water:** 3rd tee/6th green/9th tee/13th tee/15th tee

Decisions On Ties: In the event of a tie for Championship flight, there will be a 3 hole play-off on holes #10, #11, #12. If still tied, hole-by-hole play-off starting on #13 and continuing until a winner is determined. Any ties for the flights, will be broken by matching scorecards. (last 9 holes, last 6, last 3, and finally the 18th hole. If still tied, a coin flip)

Severe Weather Course Evacuation Plan

Signals **One (1)** long blast = Discontinue Play *immediately*
Two (2) short blasts = Resume play

In the event of severe weather, go to the clubhouse or the restrooms. If a player believes she is in danger from lightning, she may discontinue play *without* permission from the Committee.
