

Notice to Competitors

MWGA Match Play

July 12-15, 2010

Baker National GC

Play is governed by the USGA rules of golf, MWGA local rules and conditions, and this notice

- Tee markers:** There are two sets of tees for this tournament. Play is from the **blue** MWGA tee markers for the championship flight. All other flights will play from the **white** markers.
- Yardage Markers:** Plates in fairways at 75, 100, 125, 150, 175, and 200 yards to the middle of the green. Most sprinkler heads are marked
- Hole Locations:** Colored Flags Red=Front White=Middle Blue=Back
- Out of Bounds:** Defined by the asphalt behind the 2nd & 4th greens.
- Water Hazards:** Water hazards are *identified* by yellow stakes and may be *defined* by yellow lines. During the play of the 6th hole a ball entering the water hazard on the 7th hole should be played as a lateral water hazard.
- Lateral Water Hazards:** Lateral water hazards are *identified* by red stakes and may be *defined* by red lines.
- Ground Under Repair:** White lined areas. Relief is *mandatory* for any ball that lies in a flower bed.
- Obstructions:** All cart paths whether artificially surfaced or not. **The barn behind and to the right of the 1st green is an integral part of the course. NO RELIEF**
- Rakes:** Leave rakes *inside* the bunkers.
- Rest Areas:** Left of the 4th tee (also can be used after the 5th hole). On the 14th tee. (Follow the sign.).
- Drinking Water:** There is **NO** drinking water on the course.
- Decisions On Ties:** If a playoff for the last qualifying place(s) is necessary, it will be resolved by an immediate hole-by-hole playoff beginning on #1. Any matches tied after 18 holes will be settled by extending the stipulated round to as many holes as are required for the match to be won. The extension shall start on the hole the match began.

Severe Weather Course Evacuation Plan

Signals **One (1)** long blast = Discontinue Play *immediately*
Two (2) short blasts = Resume play

In the event of severe weather, go to the clubhouse, or to the maintenance building located to the left of the 8th tee. If a player believes she is in danger from lightning, she may discontinue play *without* permission from the Committee.
