**ELIGIBILITY**

Entries are open to amateur golfers who were female at birth, who will not reach their 19th birthday by midnight of September 1 of the tournament year, who are in good standing with the MWGA, who have not played on a college golf team, and who are permanent Minnesota residents.

**FIELD LIMITATION**

The field will be limited to the first 130 entries received. If the field is oversubscribed, an alternate list will be developed. Applicants on the alternate list will be notified by The Committee.

**ROUND:** Contact golf shop for availability.

**TUE-JULY 6:** **Registration:** Contestants must report to the registration area 30 minutes prior to tee time. 18 holes of stroke play. Reception, compliments of the MWGA, to follow a.m. and p.m. play.

**WED-JULY 7:** **Final Round**-18 holes of stroke play.

## **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

### **FLIGHTS**

Players with handicap indexes of 8.9 or less or whose average score is 82 or less shall qualify to play in the Championship Flight from the MWGA blue tee markers. Other players may elect to qualify for the Championship Flight, subject to The Committee's approval. All other players shall be placed in flights according to their handicap indexes or average score.

**Jr Girls**

### **CHAMPION**

The Champion shall be the player in the Championship Flight having the lowest gross score for 36 holes. Any tie shall be played off immediately in a unit of three holes. If the players are still tied, there shall be a sudden death play-off until the Champion is determined.

### **TROPHIES AND PRIZES**

The Champion shall be awarded the Susan Weber Memorial Trophy which will be in her possession for the ensuing year with the stipulation that the trophy shall remain in the State of Minnesota.

Medals shall be awarded as determined by The Committee. The player with the lowest gross score in the qualifying round shall be presented with a trophy which shall be in her possession for the ensuing year with the stipulation that it remain in the State of Minnesota.

Tournament entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time (either before or during the tournament) by The Committee at its discretion. All play is in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf. All decisions by The Committee in any matter concerning this tournament shall be final.
