Mid-Handicap

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers who were female at birth, are MWGA members who meet the requirements under Handicap Regulations and Limitations and who are in good standing with the MWGA. Entrants may or may not be from the same club.

HANDICAP REGULATIONS AND LIMITATIONS

1. Only a USGA Handicap Index computed under the MGA Handicap Program is acceptable.
2. The handicap as of the June 15 handicap revision date will be used for tournament eligibility.
3. MWGA entrant's current handicap index shall be between 14.0-39.0.

FIELD LIMITATION

The field will be limited to 120 players (60 teams). If the field is oversubscribed, an alternate list will be developed. Applicants on the alternate list will be notified.

Applicants may substitute one player for another prior to the tournament deadline by withdrawing the original application and reapplying. After the tournament deadline, player substitution may occur by submitting a new entry form. The substituted player must have a handicap equal to or greater than the lower handicap of the twosome and must meet all eligibility requirements. Substitutions must be received in the MWGA office two business days before the start of the tournament.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Twosomes will be paired with another twosome to make a team of four. Pairings will be made so that all foursomes have comparable handicaps. The event will be two net best balls of the foursome.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as determined by The Committee.

TIES

In the event of a tie, scorecards will be matched to determine the winning team on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If a tie remains, the winning team will be determined on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes, the 18th hole and finally by lot.
