ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers who were female at birth, who meet the requirements under Handicap Regulations and Limitations, and who are in good standing with the MWGA.

HANDICAP REGULATIONS AND LIMITATIONS

1. Only a USGA Handicap Index computed under the MGA Handicap Program is acceptable.
2. The handicap as of the August 1 handicap revision date will be used for tournament eligibility and flight placement.
3. MWGA entrant's current handicap index shall not exceed 36.0.
Non-MWGA entrant's current handicap index shall not exceed 5.9.

State Amateur

FIELD LIMITATIONS

The field will be limited to 138 players. Ties in handicap indexes for the last position will be settled by blind draw. If the field is oversubscribed, an alternate list will be developed. Applicants on the alternate list will be notified.

SCHEDULE

PRACTICE

ROUND: Contact golf shop for availability.

MON-AUG 16: First Round - 18 holes of stroke play.

TUE-AUG 17: Second Round - 18 holes of stroke play.

WED-AUG 18: Final Round - 18 holes of stroke play.
Awards ceremony and reception, compliments of the MWGA, will follow play for both the morning and afternoon groups.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

FLIGHTS

Players with handicap indexes of 5.9 or less shall qualify to play in the Championship Flight. All other players shall be placed in flights according to their handicap indexes.

CHAMPION

The Champion shall be the player in the Championship Flight having the low gross score for 54 holes. Ties shall be played off immediately in units of three holes. If the players are still tied, there shall be a sudden death play-off until the Champion is determined.

TROPHY AND PRIZES

The Champion shall be presented the Championship Trophy which shall be in her possession for the ensuing year with the stipulation that the trophy shall remain in the State of Minnesota. Medals and gift certificates shall be awarded as determined by The Committee.
