

# Notice to Competitors

MWGA Mid-Handicap

June 28th, 2010

St Cloud CC

**Play is governed by the USGA rules of golf, MWGA local rules and conditions, and this notice**

- Tee markers:** Play is from the **red** tee markers for all players.
- Yardage Markers:** Plates in the fairway are measured to the middle of the green.
- Hole Locations:** Colored 150 yard makers Red=Front; White=Middle; Blue=Back
- Out of Bounds:** White stakes, fences, and the asphalt of the road. The driving range is OB.
- Water Hazards:** Water hazards are *identified* by yellow stakes. Holes # 3, #12, #15, #16, #17.
- Lateral Water Hazards:** Lateral water hazards are *identified* by red stakes. Holes #3, #4, #10, #11, #13, #14, #15, #16, #17. Two “drop zones” have been added behind the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> greens. These can be used as an additional option under Rule 26-1 for a ball that lies in the lateral water hazard behind the green. You must use the “drop zone” that is closest to where your ball lies and you may use the “drop zone” even if it is closer to the hole than where your ball last crossed the margin of the water hazard.
- Ground Under Repair:** White lined areas. Relief is *mandatory* for any ball that lies in a flower bed. This includes the “wild flowers” to the left of the 7<sup>th</sup> tee. Refer to Rule 25-1 for relief procedure.
- Obstructions:** Refer to Rule 24. Two “drop zones” have been added behind the 2<sup>nd</sup> green. These can be used UNDER PENALTY OF ONE STROKE for any ball that goes over the 2<sup>nd</sup> green (found or not found). You must use the “drop zone” that is closest to where your ball lies.
- Rakes:** Leave rakes *inside* the bunkers.
- Rest Areas:** 5<sup>th</sup> fairway and 16<sup>th</sup> green
- Drinking Water:** Tees of the following holes: 4, 5, 8, 13, 16.
- Decisions On Ties:** Refer to the Rules of Golf page 123 Appendix I.

## Severe Weather Course Evacuation Plan

### Signals

**One (1)** long blast = Discontinue Play *immediately*

**Two (2)** short blasts = Resume play

In the event of severe weather go to the clubhouse or the maintenance building to the right of the 5<sup>th</sup> fairway. If a player believes she is in danger from lightning, she may discontinue play *without* permission from the Committee.
